

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Mountain Home City Council will hold a Public Hearing at its regular meeting on Monday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, 160 South 3<sup>rd</sup> East, Mountain Home, Idaho. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain citizen input and public comment on proposed rate increases for the City's monthly Water and Wastewater Service Charges.

### **Current Monthly Rates**

#### **WATER**

The base rate for the first 5,000 gallons of water used each month is \$22.30 per month.

The current rate for each additional 1,000 gallons of water used each month exceeding 5,000 gallons, but not more than 45,000 gallons per month, is \$1.31 per 1,000 gallons.

The current rate for each additional 1,000 gallons of water used each month exceeding 45,000 gallons per month, is \$1.62 per 1,000 gallons.

### **New Proposed Monthly Rates**

The new proposed base rate for the first 5,000 gallons of water used each month is \$26.30 per month.

The new proposed rate for each additional 1,000 gallons of water used each month exceeding 5,000 gallons, but not more than 45,000 gallons per month, is \$1.51 per 1,000 gallons.

The new proposed rate for each additional 1,000 gallons of water used each month exceeding 45,000 gallons per month is \$1.86 for each 1,000 gallons.

### **Current Monthly Rates**

#### **WASTEWATER**

The base rate for the first 5,000 gallons of wastewater each month is \$19.70 per month.

The current rate for each additional 1,000 gallons of wastewater each month exceeding 5,000 gallons per month, is \$4.20 per 1,000 gallons.

### **New Proposed Monthly Rates**

The new proposed base rate for the first 5,000 gallons of wastewater each month is \$25.70 per month.

The new proposed rate for each additional 1,000 gallons of wastewater each month exceeding 5,000 gallons per month, is \$5.40 per 1,000 gallons.

The proposed monthly rate increases shall take effect as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

Anyone who wishes to comment, but is unable to attend the hearing, may submit written comments prior to the meeting. The City of Mountain Home will provide for reasonable accommodations for persons with disabilities. Persons needing an interpreter or special accommodations are urged to contact Jamie McDaniel, the City of Mountain Home Title VI Coordinator at 208-580-2091.
