The Council of the City of Mountain Home, Elmore County, Idaho, met at Mountain Home City Hall, 160 South 3rd East, Mountain Home, Idaho on October 29th, 2024. A quorum was established with, Councilwoman Garvey, Councilman Harjo, Councilman Brennan, and Mayor Sykes being present. Councilwoman Wirkkala was present via phone.

NEW BUSINESS

1) Action Item: Deliberation/Decision concerning the declaration of the intent of the City to exchange City-owned real property for real property owned by AgEquity LLC. and set a public hearing date.

Councilman Brennan declared he didn't think the deed restriction was written how it was spoken of in executive session. He said through interlineation he would like to have it be no multilevel commercial.

Councilwoman Wirkkala read the description of approximately 2 acres from parcel RPA3S07E302700 subject to deed restriction prohibiting multilevel commercial and prohibiting residential.

Councilman Brennan declared the value of parcel RPA02000010050, RPA02000010040, RPA02000010030, and RPA3S07E302700 with a total value of \$1,331,001.58.

Councilman Harjo made a motion setting minimum value and to approve the declaration of intent of the City to exchange City-owned real property for real property owned by AgEquity LLC. and to set a public hearing date for November 26th, 2024. Councilwoman Garvey seconded the motion.


The following vote was recorded:
